 possible, we'd like to know ahead of time when you can volunteer, to help us facilitate
 our scheduling. Please let us know ahead of time if you will not be able to work your
 entire shift, as scheduled.
- At times you may be working side by side with paid staff that must adhere to a work schedule concerning breaks, lunches, etc. Please be mindful of this.
- We allow the Holy Spirit to lead us in every aspect of the store's operations. Thus, a servant's attitude of happiness, positive outlook, respect, joy and willingness to serve is expected.
- Also, please let us know what area of the store God is leading you to serve. We will try
 our best to accommodate you.
- We do ask that you dress according to the volunteer dress code and wear an apron and/or badge at all times.
- o Please be outgoing, friendly, and greet all customers (with a smile).
- Please use courtesy by letting a staff member know when you are arriving or leaving
- Please observe all of the store's safety policies, such as lifting, using step ladders, wet floors, etc.
- When working in receiving, please remember that <u>all</u> donations are a blessing to Calvary Thrift and properly thank and bless the donors. Also, all donations are gifts to Calvary Thrift Store and the property thereof.
- Any and all purchases must be made through the store; this includes items that have been discarded. Nothing is for free except what is <u>already</u> in the free bin out front.

As a volunteer I will not:

- Use, possess, or be under the influence of alcohol or illegal drugs at any time while volunteering.
- Smoke or use tobacco products in any part of the building or in store vehicles.
- Participate in any situations of unlawful harassment, including sexual harassment and harassment related to medical conditions, race, religion, gender, sexual orientation, national origin or ancestry.
- Use my cell phone on the sales-floor. (Please make personal calls on breaks, away from work areas.)
- Shop or try on any of the merchandise during my volunteer shift.
